<u>Pollution Prevention Grant Program (5-7 min)</u>: This year, Pollution Prevention has a significant increase in grant funding available to award to federally recognized Tribes, intertribal consortia, states, and other entities eligible for these competitive two-year grants. We'll share more details about this expanded funding opportunity.
