Re: Termination of Stop Sale, Use, or Removal Order Issued to Electrolux Home Products, Inc.

Ms. Jacobson:

On May 27, 2020, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued Electrolux Home Products, Inc. (Electrolux), a Stop Sale, Use, or Removal Order (Order), based on its reason to believe that Electrolux had been distributing or selling unregistered pesticides, specifically, Frigidaire-brand dehumidifier and air conditioner products that incorporated nanosilver and were labeled with pesticidal claims. The Order required that Electrolux stop all distributions and sales of such products, except for the distributions provided for by the Order.

Electrolux has informed EPA that all known products subject to the Order have either been made compliant by the replacement of their filter and removal of pesticidal claims or have been destroyed. Upon review, the EPA no longer maintains a reason to believe Electrolux is selling or distributing the products identified in the Order. Therefore, by this letter, EPA terminates the Order.
