

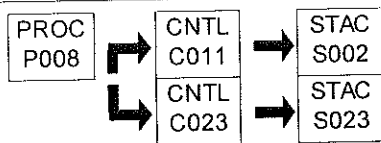
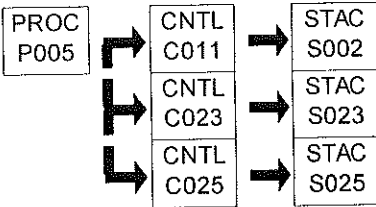

I. RESTRICTIONS.**Emission Restriction(s).**

(a) VOC Emissions shall not exceed the following 12 month rolling sum of VOC emissions for each source:

- (1) Source ID P005 - 9.43 tons/12 month rolling average.
- (2) Source ID P008 - 80.87 tons/12 month rolling average.
- (3) Source ID P016 - 9.22 tons/12 month rolling average.

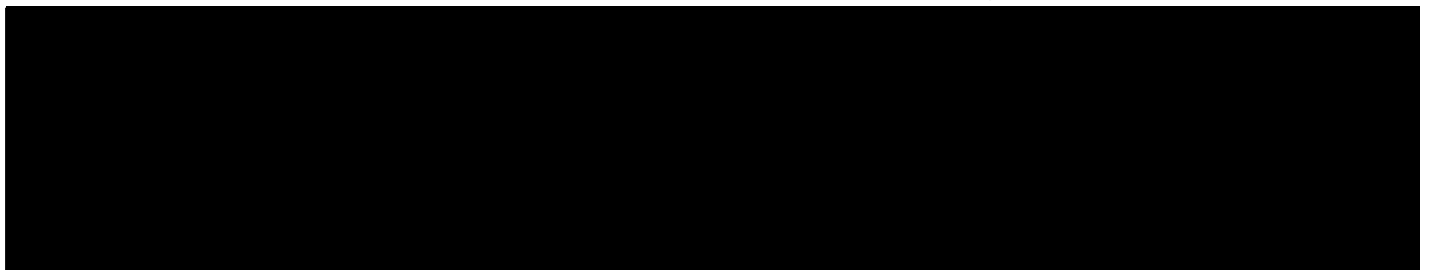

(a) The following throughput requirement applies to both Source ID P005 and P008.

- (1) The throughput capacity shall not exceed 134,784 tons of scrap metal/year based on 7,488 hours/year.

(b) The following throughput requirement applies to Source ID P016.

- (1) The throughput capacity shall not exceed 60,000 tons of sand / year based on 8,760 hours/year.

**IV. RECORDKEEPING REQUIREMENTS.**

**SECTION E. Source Group Restrictions.**

(a) The permittee shall maintain records of monthly and 12-month rolling VOC emissions from sources, as applicable, and shall keep records of the VOC emissions pursuant to 25 Pa. Code § 129.100, including emissions unit throughputs and emissions factors.

(b) The permittee shall maintain sufficient records to demonstrate compliance with RACT II requirements. Sufficient records may include, but are not limited to:

- (i) Annual compliance reports.
- (ii) Production data.
- (iii) Preventative maintenance program records.

VI. WORK PRACTICE REQUIREMENTS.

Operating permit terms and conditions.

At a minimum, the following work practices shall be followed:

- (a) The permittee shall operate all equipment associated with VOC emissions in accordance with the Best Management Practices established by the manufacturer or an approved management plan approved by the Department. Records of maintenance performed at applicable emissions units must be kept in accordance to recordkeeping requirements.
- (b) The permittee shall maintain all equipment in accordance with manufacturers specifications and maintain records of any maintenance performed.
- (c) The aforementioned source(s) may only be operated as long as the sources are operated and maintained in accordance with the specifications set forth in the respective operating permit(s), and the application(s) submitted for said operating permit(s) (as approved by the Department), and in accordance with any conditions set forth herein.
- (d) The sources shall be operated and maintained in accordance with the manufacturers specification and with good engineering & air pollution control practices.
- (e) Employee training detailing good work practices to operate aforementioned sources for minimizing emissions; and
- (f) Periodic inspection of production and operating activities.
