I am responding to the petition submitted by the Texas Public Policy Foundation on behalf of Liberty Packing Company LLC and others to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, titled "Petition to Reconsider Endangerment and Cause or Contribute Findings for Greenhouse Gases Under Section 202(a) of the Clean Air Act (TPP petition)."
