> Attached are the final fiscal FY 2021 Small Underserved and Disadvantaged Communities Tribal grant regional allotments. The total appropriations made available for this program is \$25,880,000. The final allotment made available to the American Indian & Alaska Native Villages/Tribal Allotment is \$2,641,000 to support tribal water systems.

> The grant implementation document is under revision and anticipated for release in Summer 2022. Regions will be notified when the implementation document is available and will develop regional processes to identify eligible activities and recipients to administer funding according to the guidance in the document.
