

Thank you for your letter of April 8, 2022, regarding the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) comments and recommendations on the draft waste permit and compliance plan for the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) site in Houston's Fifth Ward/Kashmere Gardens. Thank you also for inviting our Regional staff to participate in the THEA/Impact Fifth Ward community meeting on April 19, 2022. It was a valuable opportunity to share information with the community and to hear their concerns. We appreciate your suggestions for strengthening the comments regarding community involvement and transparency. Consistent with these suggestions, EPA has shared your letter with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ).

EPA will continue coordinating with TCEQ to ensure that the community's concerns are addressed, and We encourage you to share your suggestions directly with TCEQ. As the primary regulatory authority for the UPRR Houston Wood Preserving Works site, TCEQ is currently taking comments on the draft permit for cleanup of the site through May 10, 2022.

We will continue to monitor communications with the community as the permit moves through the approval process.
