
# Water comes in three different forms:





Solid



Water is stored underground between rocks, sand, and clay in an aquifer.



Only 3% of water on earth is fresh water and we need water to live.




To conserve water, turn off the water when you're not using it and tell an adult when you see a leak.





How much water is used when flushing a toilet?




Old models ~ 6 gallons per flush

How much water does the average US household use?




~ 300 gallons of water per day
