This letter is to notify you that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Office of Civil Rights (OCR), received your correspondence on November 10, 2015, containing a DVD-R. This DVD-R, labeled **(b) (6) - Privacy** interviews, appears to have been sent in place of a written correspondence.

However, after several attempts, OCR has been unable to open the DVD-R to read its contents. If possible, please print the contents of the DVD-R so that OCR can view them, or try to send them again in another format or on another type of media, such as a "finalized" CD-R.

OCR is responsible for processing and investigating complaints alleging discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, disability and age, by programs or activities that receive financial assistance from EPA. Once you re-send the contents from the DVD-R, OCR will review the correspondence to determine whether it is a complaint within OCR's jurisdiction. Once this jurisdictional review is completed, OCR will notify you about its decision.
