The Office of the Chief Inspector General received your complaint on March 19, 2016, in which you expressed concerns about the handling of your public records request by the Executive Office of the Governor, Office of Open Government. Also you expressed concerns about the conduct of a city manager in St. Augustine, Florida, and the contamination of the city's drinking water. Furthermore you expressed concerns about the veto of a proposed grant for the City of St. Augustine's sewer system.
