PUBLIC MEETING OCTOBER 15, 2009

 No meetings of the Subcommittee were held during the last 2 quarters of FY 2009

Activities reported concern uranium and water TENORM

Uranium:

- As of October 12, spot market price of uranium had dropped from ~\$58/lb to \$46.50
- NRC final GEIS on ISL uranium milling facilities released 6/08 with announced intention to prepare Supplemental EISs for each new facility proposed
- NRC proposed uranium ISL groundwater protection rule in development
- EPA has begun its regulatory reviews of uranium CAA implementing regulations 40 CFR 61, Subpart W for active tailings impoundments; UMTRCA implementing radiation and environmental protection regulations 40 CFR 192

Uranium

- EPA, DOE, NRC, Indian Health Service, and Bureau of Indian Affairs continue joint program to assist Navajo Nation on health and environmental issues related to uranium hazards on their Tribal lands.
- Stakeholder meeting planned 11/2009 to evaluate progress of the efforts, as well as discuss New Mexico uranium legacy issues

- Uranium cont.
 - Navajo contaminated wells project:
 - EPA, Navajo EPA, CDC sampling and identification of uranium/radium/metals contaminated wells
 - Posting of signs at contaminated wells
 - Outreach effort to advise Navajo citizens not to use water from contaminated sources of water

EPA conferences in Spring 2009 in Arizona and New Mexico had 72 participants from Navajo, Hopi, and Pueblo Tribes, as well as other federal agencies
