ISCORS Working Group on Operational Guidelines (OGT) Manual



- Two Interagency Meetings: Spring and Summer 2013
- OGT familiarization and review of: Current Scenarios: Realistic?
- Other potential Scenarios:
 - IND Scenarios: Vibrant Response Exercise
 - DOT: Contamination at port entries
 - Screening criteria's for shipping containers
 - Farmers to return to site for milking of cows. Group D does not adequately address farming or agricultural scenarios. FRMAC looks at Farmer as a Worker
 - Plane flying or landing in contaminated area or airborne plume
- Implementation of IND/RDD:
 - Currently RESRAD-RDD is being updated to Microsoft Basic Code and inclusion of additional IND radionuclide. Alignment with FRMAC.
 - Source terms been updated by Sandia National Labs for U and Pu IND sources. Implementation to OGT and to FRMAC manuals



ISCORS Working Group on OGT Manual(Cont.)



- Best Available Technology
 - ICRP 60 or ICRP 103? Currently can select for ICRP 30 or 60 on RESRAD-RDD.
 - Update of new dose coefficients supporting ICRP 103
 - Additional use of ORNL DCFPak 3 been worked with Sandia National Labs
 - Consider using only age and gender weighted dose coefficients during Intermediate and Delayed phase.
 - Update of FGRs 11, 12 and 13 coming up.
 - 2013 Interim PAG Manual.
