It's my understanding that the lady is saying that she is (b) (6) Privacy and can't leave her home. She is saying that she ask the inspectors to come in her home and watch a video that she had made regarding a vehicle body shop's emissions. The inspectors did not remain in the home due to the odor in her house (related to her having dogs). Her claim is that she can't leave her home due to her disability and because they did not remain in the house they did not accommodate her situation. I have spoken to one of the inspectors (David Shivel) and he says they have been to the home multiple times and have seen a video that she sent to the office. They are unable to quantify the emissions based on what's in the video. They have relayed this to her and they have also spoken to the husband outside the home. The irony of the situation is that in one of her initial complaints she stated she was in her car contacting them because she had to leave her home due to the odor of paint coming from the body shop. I have a few more details I will be glad to relay if you would like to hear them.
