I received a referral letter from the DOJ and I hope that they have provided you with the documents I originally submitted. I have additional documents that I was denied access to originally by The EEC of KY but the Ky Attorney General ruling that they had violated the Open Records Act allowed me to receive additional and quite disturbing documents. I am attaching two of those. One is from the ADA/504 Coordinator for EEC, Nina Hockensmith and the second from the investigator who submitted her report concerning the visit on the day in question.

Ms. Hockensmith is the one who determined if there had been an ADA violation. She used a report from the investigator to make her determination. As can be seen from the attachments, my concerns are: The joking tone in which she is emailing others about my "serious" complaint and then the email from the investigator which suggests she can add or delete whatever is needed or not needed. Seeing this made me all the more certain that my original complaint was never investigated properly or taken seriously. I do not expect government workers who are ADA Coordinators to joke about citizens who are making serious complaints.

Please let me know what steps will be taken next and if there is a different procedure I will need to use to add this additional information.
