Aloha! Dear Acting Assistant Director Laura Bachle :

Re: My DOL CRC (b) (6) Privacy complaint transferred to EPA OCR

I wish to ask for your wonderful and professional rescuing me on my complaint against the discrimination by Wastewater Division in DDC of City and County of Honolulu.

Understanding that the EPA has professional business to do with the City of Honolulu, with Consent Decrees 1995 and 2010, my complaint is partially involved with professional issues, thus can be under EPA's authority.

May our EPA OCR please take care of the professional-affair issues in my complaint against WD as follows:

- CCH to have an Acknowledgement of my credits to have rediscovered and recommended the "24-hr Design Rainfall" with efforts during 2004-2012, which enabled 2,100 mi of sewers fixed since 2012;
- Recognizing my efforts to have reminded WD to learn lessons from earlier failed sewer flow modeling required by Consent Decrees 1995 and 2010, instead of discharging me effectively in ethnic cleansing;
- Confirm my contribution to revise the sewer Design Standards on designing adequate daily flow self-cleaning velocities, instead of blocking me from promotion by an ethnic "glass ceiling";
- Recognizing my professional and kind/humble attitude and technical knowledge, including my serving as Committee Member in HWEA, to help WD correct their critical misconducts; etc..

(Meanwhile I am suggesting that the DOL CRC to take care of my case with the Labor-affair issues, with following and possibly more items:

- WD's violation on my civil rights by not providing correct and complete documents with correct page numbers and Table of Contents, in past months and now;
- WD's violation on the contract by not following regulation to discuss with me on other 9 + 1 professional job positions available inside DDC, while firing me;
- WD promoted those who made important mistakes in sewer projects but with their same Japanese ethnic background, while having wrongfully discharged me without their same ethnicity. etc. etc.)
