Dear Director:

I am first and foremost a American citizen which therefore give me as my birth rights, civil (as well as Constitutional rights) rights. People of color (those which were in slavery) had no right and no say-so over their life. However as of 1865 slavery was abolished and civil, constitutional and judicial laws also affected the people of color who had been freed from bondage and slavery. As a matter of fact civil rights were guaranteed to the individual by the 13th, 14th, 15th and 19th Amendments to the constitution of the United States and by other acts of congress; esp., exemption from involuntary servitude, and equal treatment of all people with respect to the enjoyment of life, liberty, and property and to the protection of law. On June 1, 1988 while I was serving five (5) days in the Knox County facility in the City of Knoxville, state of Tennessee, two (2) men came to

the Knox County facility and lead me [redacted] to believe that they were taking me to a hearing at the city court. (after all I was serving five (5) days for (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy for the reasons why (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy

Privacy once I was hand and ankle chained I was placed in a stationwagon and the wagon headed in the direction of I 75 which in the opposite direction of where the city court is located. When they got to I 75 they head north away from the state of Tennessee. I began to ask where they were taking me, the two (2) men refuse to answer any of my questions nor tell me who they were and why they were abducting me from the city and state where I live, no answer.

on June 3, 1988 the two (2) men took me to the state prison of southern Michigan in the City of Jackson, in the state of Michigan. In Tennessee I had no legal process nor in Michigan. It was not until I got to the prison in Jackson, Michigan that I was told I was charge with prison escape, and my name was (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy my prison number was (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy at that point I requested to be finger-

printed but the prison official refused to do so. as they know I could prove, that I am (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy and not (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy according to prison records of (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy. He went home on parole in 1981. (see proofs attached) The escape charge the Jackson County prosecutor Joseph S. Filip did away with the charges. (they came with people of color and continue a person of color in false imprisonment where I have been since June 3, 1988. The courts in Michigan have no concern for the rights of people of color, including the governor.

I am requesting for a investigation to get arrest warrants for all the people who violated my civil rights. I just get Joseph S. Filip criminal plot from my P.C. four and a half months ago, (4½) I didn't even know it existed.
