Dear Amththu Hoang, Acting Director:

Today I received a reply to my November 2, 2022 Complaint. Somehow you got a misinterpretation as to what I was telling you.

Let me write my criminal complaint over. I resided in the County of Knox, City of Knoxville in the state of Tennessee. on June 1, 1988, while I was in the Knox County facility serving a five (5) day sentence for driving under the influence of alcohol, when two (2) unknown men abducted me from the city of Knoxville in the state of Tennessee, (where I had no legal process of any kind, nor was I informed of any criminal charges I may be requested for) and against my will and absent all legal authority did transport me through interstate commerce, in violation of due process and on June 3, 1988, I arrived at the state prison of southern Michigan in the city of Jackson in the state of Michigan. The two unknown men who transported me to Mich-

igan absent all legal authority, left me at the prison  
as a (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy as a escapee. My name  
is (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy and I have never been to any  
prison. I have continuously requested to be fingerprinted  
to prove I am (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy

(b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(C) Enf. Privacy But the prison officials continue to deny  
me. why do they treat me different then most people.  
all people can be identified by there fingerprints, so can I.

## Civil Rights:

Those rights guaranteed to the individual  
by the 13th, 14th, 15th and 19th amendment  
to the Constitution of the United States  
and by other acts of congress; esp., . . . .,  
and equal treatment of all people with respect  
to the enjoyment of life, liberty, and  
property and to the protection of law.

I have been falsely incarcerated in the Michigan  
penal system for almost thirty-six (36) years, due  
to my abduction in 1988 from Tennessee to Michigan,  
and the fact the Jackson County prosecuting att-



armey, Joseph S. filip went outside the court to stop me from going before a court of law which denied my due process rights and my civil rights as well as constitutional rights.

"Due Process":

U.S. Const. Amend XIV and Michigan Const. art. 1. § 17 guarantee that no state shall deprive any person of life, liberty or property, without due process of law.

Now perhaps the restating of my complaint will now be more clear now that the facts have been stated where you can better be able to comprehend my complaint. My rights has been removed from me unlawfully. I am sending proofs with this communication. [REDACTED] and myself are two (2) different human beings. This complaint do come with your jurisdiction.
