Manganese Interference With Disinfectant Residual Methods

This presentation will provide a summary of manganese occurrence in public water systems and describe its potential interference with commonly used methods to measure disinfectant residual.

Management of Manganese and Small System Considerations

Treatment of manganese is an ongoing concern for operational, esthetic and, more recently, health reasons. Manganese release events can cause discolored water but also release other regulated metals of health concern (e.g. lead, arsenic) into the distributed water. This presentation will outline management strategies for manganese including small system considerations.
