The permittee is authorized to receiving waters of the Pecos River in Waterbody Segment Code No. 20.6.4.207 of the Truchas Pecos Basin, from a facility located at 179 Sewer Plant Road in De Baca County. The designated uses of this segment are irrigation, marginal warm water aquatic life, livestock watering, wildlife habitat and primary contact.

Under the SIC Code 4952, the discharge is from a POTW. This is a renewal of a permit previously issued April 20, 2018, with an effective date of May 1, 2018, and an expiration date of April 30, 2023.

Changes from the previous permit are:

- A. Designated uses of the receiving water changed from Secondary to Primary Contact per the new and approved NMWQS.
- B. Limits for E. coli has been changed to a monthly geometric mean of 126 cfu/100 mL or MPN/100 ml, [and] a single sample of E. coli bacteria of 410 cfu/100 mL or MPN/100 mL.
- C. Maximum Total Residual Chlorine limit has changed to  $11 \mu g/l$ .
- D. Critical Dilution changed to 14% because of an updated 4Q3 critical low flow.
- E. WET limits have been revised and changed due to updated 4Q3 critical low flow.
- F. Added influent data reporting requirements for BOD<sub>5</sub> and TSS on DMRs.
- G. Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs), bypass and anticipated bypass events shall be electronically reported to EPA per 40 CFR 127.26(f).
