




# Brownfields Potential Funding:

# **Actual Budget**

- \$130 M for the Brownfields program
- This translates to increases in grant awards amounts
- In FY23, tribes will receive \$4,039,447 in Tribal Response grants
- FY23 awards for competitive programs to be announced in May 2023

## Bipartisan Infrastructure Law

- \$1.5 B in Brownfields Funding over 5 years (\$300 M / year)
- \$240 M per year for competitive grants as well as Targeted Brownfields Assessments
   \$60 M per year to enhance state and Tribe voluntary clean-up programs under a non-competitive allocation process

## **Underground Storage Tanks:**

### In FY23:

- OUST had \$323,400 EPM, \$1,192,500 F Prevention, and \$1,981,000 F
   Clean-up to allocate across all Regions.
- Region 9 received \$290,000 of contract funding to clean-up releases, also carrying over \$869,614 in prior year funding for Navajo Nation cooperative agreements.
