Aloha Everyone,

Following the <u>Aqueous Film Forming Foam (AFFF) AFFF concentrate release</u> on November 29, 2022, EPA sent the Navy a Request for Information (RFI) letter about the cleanup, monitoring and remediation of the release, and any other releases of AFFF. EPA requested information on 7 items with a deadline of March 15, 2023, for responses to be provided. The Navy provided all requested responses by the March 15 deadline. To promote transparency, we are sharing these responses with you.

A summary of the items requested in the RFI are:

- 1. Describe Nov 2022 and Sept 2020 releases of AFFF and all known <u>PFAS</u> releases, including PFAS monitoring data, amounts released, and maps of contaminated areas.
- 2. Identify water infrastructure in the immediate vicinity of contaminated areas.
- 3. Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system output data.
- 4. Provide lab reports for all PFAS analytical results from groundwater monitoring locations *Available on Navy's Electronic Data Management System*.
- 5. Provide lab reports for all PFAS analytical results from drinking water sources Available on Navy's Electronic Data Management System.
- 6. Describe Navy's efforts to remediate the Nov 2022 AFFF release and all other known PFAS releases.
- 7. Describe or provide the Navy's plan for addressing detections of PFAS in sole source drinking water aquifer.

It is EPA's priority to share information with the people of O'ahu as soon as it becomes available, and the two documents attached have been cleared by the Navy for public release. The first attachment in this message includes the Navy's responses to items 1 - 3, 6 & 7. The second attachment is the supporting document to fully respond to item #1. Information responding to questions 4 and 5 of EPA's RFI are available on the Navy's Electronic Data Management System and no additional responses were required.

We are working with the Navy to release additional documentation to the public. In the interim, EPA continues to move forward with our investigation of the incident.
