This letter concerns EPA Complaint No. 13R-14-R6. On March 28, 2019, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) External Civil Rights Compliance Office (ECRCO) was informed by EPA's Alternative Dispute Resolution Law Office that the Recipients (the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board and the City of Albuquerque's Environmental Health Department) and the Complainants (New Mexico Environmental Law Center on behalf of the SouthWest Organizing Project) in this case have agreed to engage in Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR).

Accordingly, as of the date of this letter, ECRCO is suspending its investigation of the subject complaint for the duration of the ADR process.
