Dear Mr. Schavey:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), at the request of Mr. Eric Walker of your staff, has re-evaluated the petition response that was sent to you on January 19, 2012, in which EPA approved a three-tiered alternative data substitution methodology for common stack CSGA12 at the Gallatin Fossil Plant. As a result of this re-evaluation the Agency has found that the approved correction factor for Tier 1 was incorrect, due to an error in the formula that was applied.

The approved correction factor for Tier 1 should be 1.044, rather than 1.063, as indicated in the January 19, 2012 petition response. None of the other information provided in that petition response is affected by this finding. Therefore, when the affected quarterly reports for Common Stack CSGA12 are resubmitted, please ensure that a correction factor of 1.044 is applied to the Tier 1 data.
