NW Natural is **seeking pipeline-quality RNG resources and/or the associated environmental attributes** from a variety of feedstocks and sources around the country, including renewable hydrogen.

NW Natural is soliciting proposals from qualified firms to **sell RNG from existing or future projects**. Delivery of the resource to NW Natural must begin no later than December 31, 2025.
