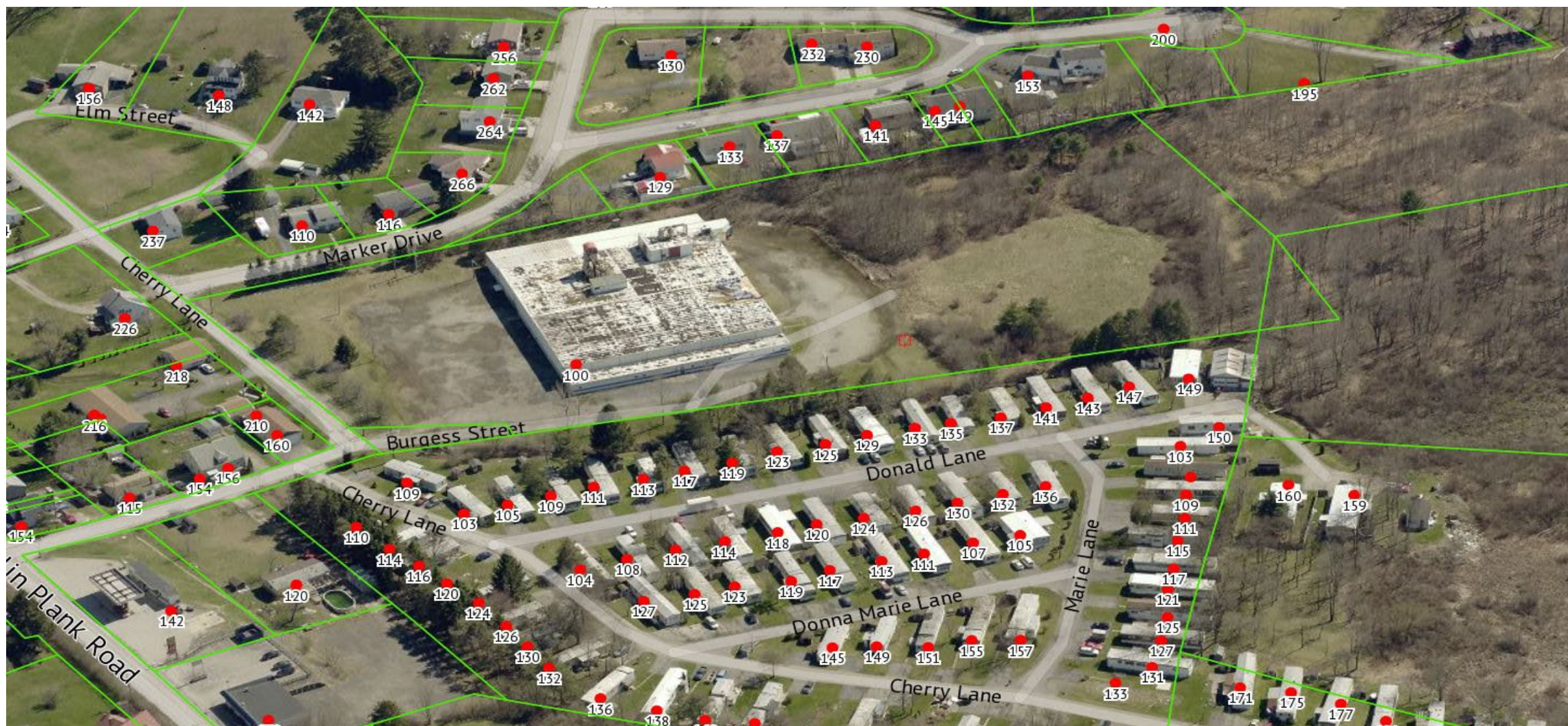

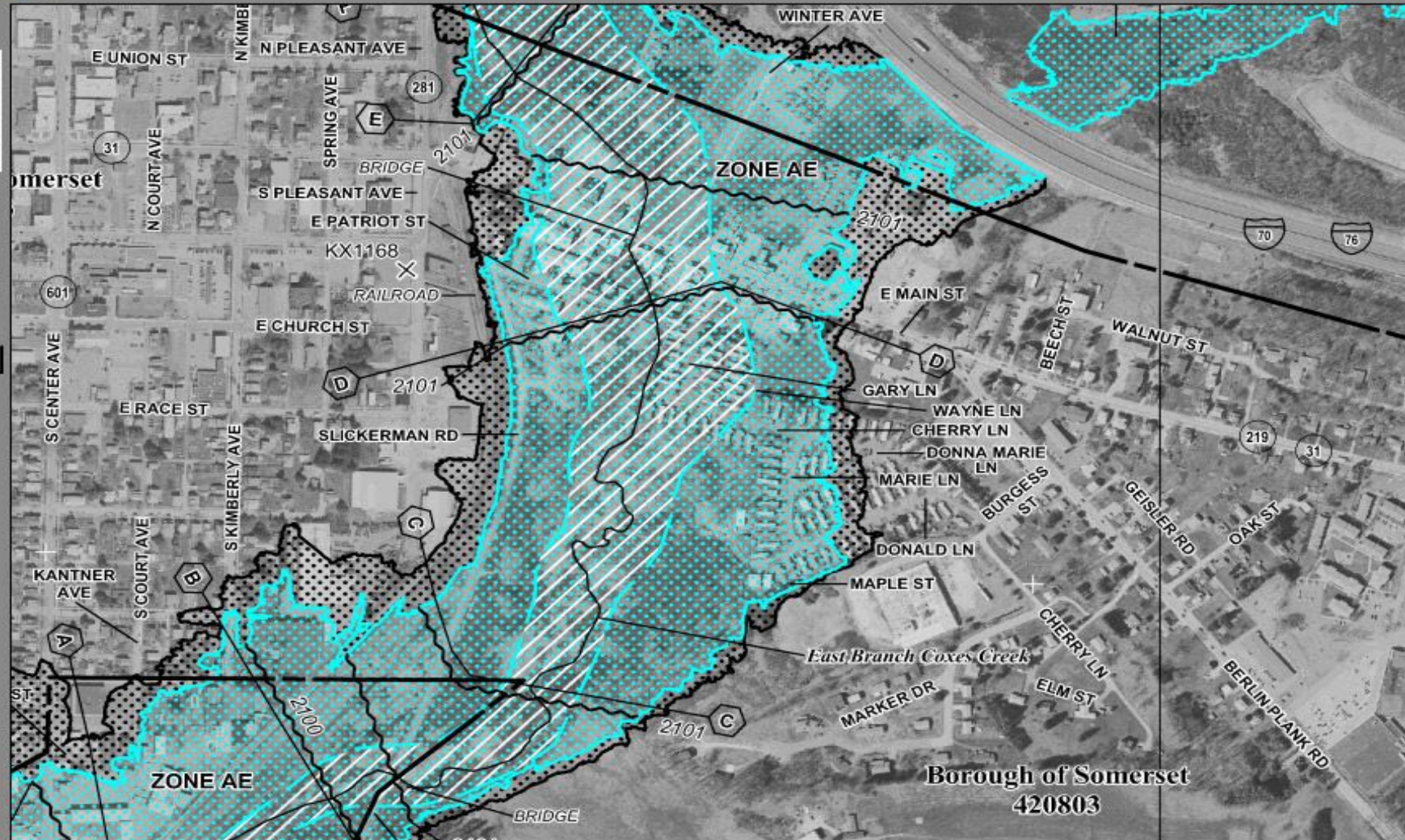

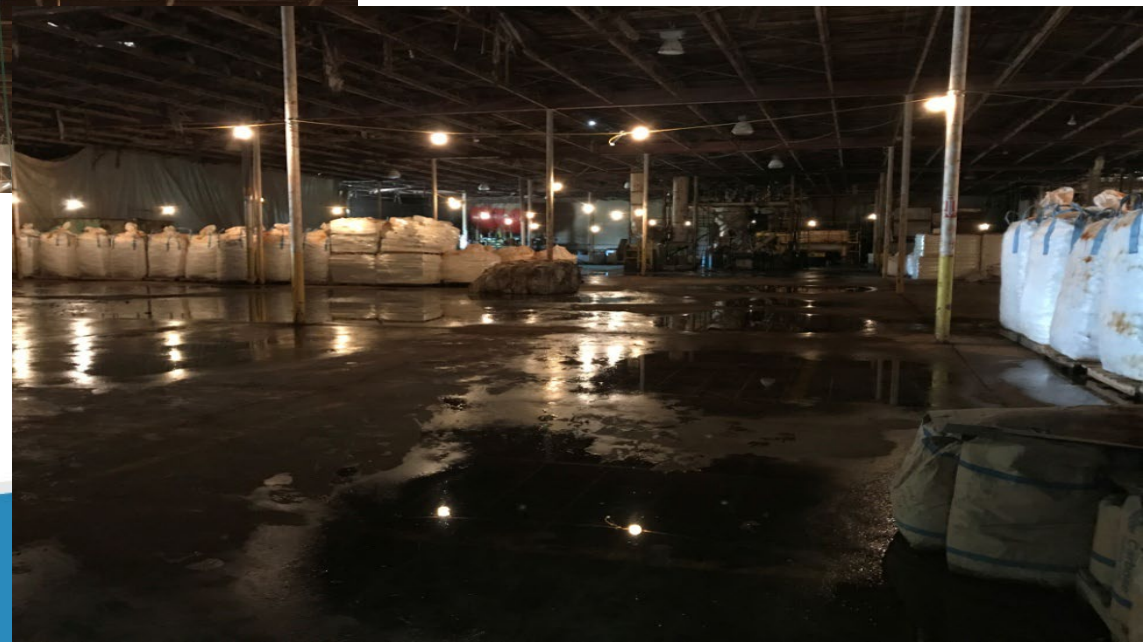

Administrative Record Available for Public Review

PENN CARBOSE SITE

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency announces the availability of the Administrative Record (AR) for removal activities conducted at the Penn Carbose Site in Somerset, where EPA experts have secured abandoned hazardous substances improperly stored in tanks and other containers which posed an immediate threat to public health and the environment. The AR contains documents about cleanup activities conducted at the site which ensure public health and the environment are protected.
