### EPA Response – Basic Overview

- Duty Officers answer Spill Line 24/7/365
- Dispatch On-Scene Coordinators (OSCs) to emergency incidents requiring immediate response
- Conduct Longer-term Response Actions and Cleanup
- Deploy personnel to disasters










## EPA Response – Plan and Prepare

- Plan and Prepare
- ✓ Exercise and train with response partners
- ✓ Regional Response Team
- ✓ Outreach into subareas and communities









#### EPA Response - Assess and Evaluate

- OSCs evaluate and assess releases of hazardous substances and discharges of oil i.a.w. National Contingency Plan
- Objective: Determine if incident warrants federal action and if a responsible party is not completing appropriate actions







## EPA Response - Action

- OSCs have authority to initiate response action in emergency situations (EPA managers approve planned actions and costs)
- OSCs direct the response actions and coordinate with State and Local authorities








### **EPA Response - Communication**
