Hyundai Motor America (“Hyundai”) requests an extension to the comment deadline for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency’s (“EPA”) notice of proposed rulemaking (“NPRM”) entitled, “Multi-Pollutant Emission Standards for Model Years 2027 and Later Light-Duty and Medium-Duty Vehicles.”

Due to the quantity of information included in the NPRM and the time needed for the company to perform a thorough review as is necessary for a rule of such importance, and in the interest of regulatory coordination, we kindly request that the July 5, 2023, deadline be extended to align with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration’s Corporate Average Fuel Economy proposed rulemaking comment deadline once that rule is released. If this is not possible, we request an extension to August 7, 2023.

This request is aligned with the Alliance for Automotive Innovation’s (“AAI”) request made on May 25, 2023, on behalf of its 42 member companies (including Hyundai)
