- Applied mitigations and terms/conditions of approval





WATER QUALITY PROGRAM

ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING UNIT

- Water Quality Coordinates with:
 - U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit issues
 - Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM) on research and water quality analysis needs
 - U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) on issues involving general pollution prevention and National Response Center reports (internal database)
 - BSEE Regional and District Field Operations Offices and Oil Spill Preparedness Division (OSPD)
- Conducts field compliance verification through risk-based planning and inspections
- Enforces non-compliance and ensures effective corrective action requirements



INTERAGENCY COORDINATION

HOW BSEE, BOEM, AND EPA WORK TOGETHER

- A 1984 MOU between DOI and EPA established procedures for cooperation for issuing and enforcing NPDES General Permits for OCS facilities
 - Under the MOU BSEE conducts inspections of OCS Facilities on EPA's behalf
- Existing regional MOAs between BSEE and EPA Regional Offices further outline NPDES responsibilities to address:
 - Post lease monitoring
 - Inspection and enforcement roles and procedures

ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING UNIT

Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act

• 30 CFR 250.300 Subchapter C- Pollution Prevention and Control

• Clean Water Act

- Principal statute governing pollution control and water quality
- Establishes conditions and requires permitting for discharge of pollutants into the waters of the U.S. under the National pollutant Discharge Elimination System



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
WATER QUALITY INSPECTIONS

ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING UNIT

- Risk assessment matrix database using NRC reports that follows trends or commonalities of releases by:
 - reoccurring responsible party
 - Equipment type
 - Pollutant type
 - Particular practice
- History of incidents of non compliance
- EPA input
- District input
- Production rates
- Water quality inspection history

KEY TAKE-AWAY MESSAGES

BSEE is responsible for implementing and enforcing most environmental regulations on the OCS that fall under DOI jurisdiction.

• We use the full range of enforcement tools available to ensure a high level of compliance, encourage safe and environmentally sound results, and verify that the operator is conducting all operations within BSEE's purview in a safe and responsible manner.

BSEE Water Quality, BOEM, and EPA all work together on the OCS under MOAs
