PETITION FOR REVIEW

Under 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1) and Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 15(a), Petitioner Energy Transfer LP petitions this Court for review of Respondents United States Environmental Protection Agency and Administrator Michael S. Regan's promulgation of a federal implementation plan for Missouri regarding the interstate transport requirements of 42 U.S.C. § 7410(a)(2)(d)(i)(I) for the 2015 8-hour ozone national ambient air quality standard, titled "Federal 'Good Neighbor Plan' for the 2015 Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards," 88 Fed. Reg. 36,654 (June

5, 2023) ("Final Rule").* See FED. R. APP. P. 15(a)(2)(C) ("The petition must . . . specify the order or part thereof to be reviewed."). EPA has no authority to promulgate a FIP for Missouri unless and until it has lawfully disapproved Missouri's state implementation plan. 42 U.S.C. § 7410(c)(1). This Court recently granted Missouri Petitioners a stay of EPA's disapproval of Missouri's state implementation plan. Order, Missouri v. EPA, No. 23-1719 (8th Cir. May 26, 2023); Order, Union Elec. Co. v. EPA, No. 23-1751 (8th Cir. May 26, 2023).

Jurisdiction and venue lie in this Court under 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1). The challenged action's promulgation of a FIP for Missouri is a "locally or regionally applicable" action and is not "based on a determination of nationwide scope or effect." *See id.* This petition for review is timely filed within sixty days of the challenged action's publication in the Federal Register. *See* 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1). Petitioner requests that the Court vacate, set aside, and hold unlawful the EPA's promulgation of the FIP for Missouri.
