Tribal & State Collaboration

Climate Pollution Reduction Grant (CPRG)

- CPRG provides grants to **states**, local governments, **tribes**, and territories to develop and implement plans for reducing greenhouse gas emissions and other harmful air pollution.
- This **two-phase grant program** provides funding of \$250 million for noncompetitive planning grants, and \$4.6 billion for competitive implementation grants.
 - California, Arizona, & Nevada were awarded planning grants.
 - In R9 we received \$5.9 million for tribes, we were able to fund 21 grants covering up to 53 tribes.
- Phase 1: Planning Grant -> Phase 2: Implementation

CPRG Next Steps:

- States, local governments, tribes, and territories are now beginning work on their CPRG grants.
- Tribes who did not receive their own CPRG planning grant are still eligible & encouraged to participate:
 - Option 1: Collaborate with regional state.
 - Option 2: Collaborate with local metropolitan area (if applicable)
- If your project is included in a State or Metropolitan PCAP, you will be eligible to apply for Implementation \$'s.
 - PCAP: Priority Climate Action Plan
- Arizona, California, & Nevada have committed to conducting outreach to tribes and including tribal input in planning deliverables.

TRIBAL OUTREACH ENSURING MEANINGFUL ENGAGEMENT

In 2003, a Tribal Liaison Program was established to help facilitate work between Tribal Nations and NDEP on environmental issues that may affect Tribal Nations in Nevada. Through the Tribal Liaison Program, the Nevada Tribal Government Consultation Protocols were established to provide frameworks for government-to-government relationship between the Tribes of Nevada and NDEP.

NDEP is planning to coordinate with all interested Tribal Nations through NDEP's Tribal Liaison and the Inter-Tribal Council of Nevada.

- Host ongoing in-person meetings across Nevada, with options to participate online, to provide status updates and solicit feedback.
- Continuously seek input throughout the duration of CPRG program development
