



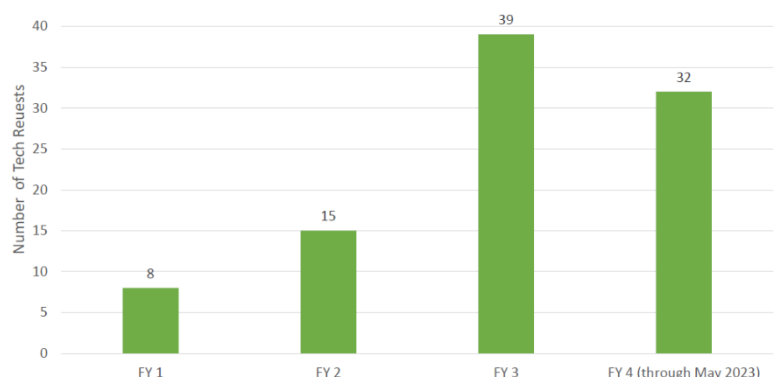
## Our Impact on SNEP Communities

- Helped SNEP communities secure of **\$2 MILLION** to advance their stormwater and climate resilience projects
- Brought together **16 regional technical assistance providers, 15 Federal and State Entities, and 14 consultants** to support over **77 municipalities, Tribes, and community organizations** in the SNEP region advance projects and implement climate solutions
- Completed over **16 Community Projects** with **8 communities successfully securing funds** to advance their stormwater and climate resilience projects

## Trainings + Webinars

- 35 webinars delivered to date
- Over 2380 attendees of total webinar attendees to date
- Average of 97 webinar attendees
- Stormwater Planning Series: 9 participating communities (2 Cohorts)
- Bylaw Review Trainings: 57 participants (2 In-Person Workshops)

We are seeing *a positive trend in the number of technical assistance requests* from SNEP communities since the Network's first year.



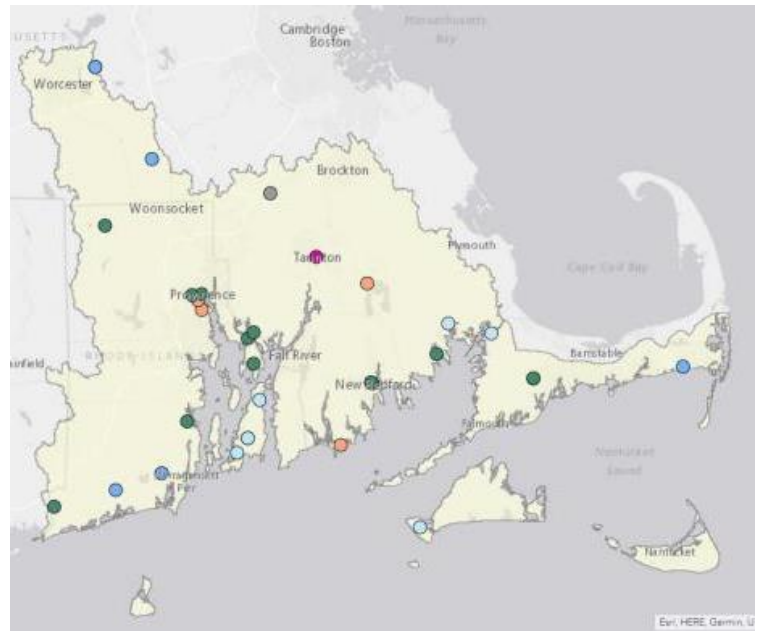
*\*\*Graph above shows request through to May 2023. We are anticipating FY4 requests to exceed the previous year by the end of fiscal year.*

# Community Assistance Projects

Community Assistance Projects offer in-depth technical, financial, and training assistance to municipalities, tribes, and non-profits in the SNEP region. The SNEP Network responds to SNEP communities' project needs, helps advance their level of practice, and assists with moving them towards funding, financing, and implementation. We make our services available to communities through an open solicitation process where communities respond with their needs for technical assistance and training.

## Community Projects

- **30 Community Assistance Projects** awarded free technical assistance by the SNEP Network through a solicitation/application process.
- **16 completed community assistance projects** with the remaining to be completed by the end of FY4 or FY5 (September 2024).
- **8 projects** to date have secured funding to advance projects.



## SNEP Network Pilot Projects

**Maidford River Watershed Restoration Project:** assisting the Town of Middletown and Aquidneck Land Trust with planning and design for nature-based solutions to reduce flooding and improve water quality of the Maidford River and two downstream drinking water reservoirs.

**Taunton River Watershed Project:** assisting the Towns of Easton, Foxborough, Mansfield, Norton, and Sharon, Massachusetts to enhance the protection of the Canoe River Aquifer using Nature Based Solutions
