

Case 1: Uniontown, Alabama REALITY

EXPECTATION


- Site 15 monitors throughout community at fenceline locations
- Collect Daily "Odor Diary" entries and compare to emissions data

- MOU, but no QAPP

- Limited Access to Sites
- Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues
- Alabama Summer
- Science Communication
- Participant Fatigue = Inconsistent Results











Case 2: Cheverly, Maryland

EXPECTATION

- Suburban landscape and collaboration with City and State offices will remove barriers

REALITY

- QAPP, but no MOU
- Better results, better outcomes
- Project sustainability still a major issue
- Had to work around City/MDE schedule



Case 3: Atlanta, Georgia

- Multiple stakeholder group approach
 - Community-based Organizations
 - AQ Consultants
 - Sensor Manufacturer
 - Government
 - Higher Education

Dual purpose monitoring

- FEM stationary monitoring for comparison to State data
- Low-Cost personal monitoring for participatory science, community engagement









MAKE IT COUNT! Start with the *community's* end in mind.

- Know what policy ACTIONS are desired, possible, and likely
- MOU's are like QAPPs for community partnerships (co-create!)
- Low-Cost ≠ No Cost esp. for EJ communities failure can be expensive

It Takes A Village. Build A Diverse Team.

 Successful community monitoring programs are based on relationships between sector and stakeholder groups

Beware: QA & Community-based Monitoring is Easier in Affluent Communities
