SUMMARY & DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION: EPA is providing notice of a proposed administrative penalty assessment for alleged violations of the Clean Water Act (CWA). EPA is also providing notice of opportunity to comment on the proposed administrative complaint filed on October 25, 2023, with the Regional Hearing Clerk.

Under 33 U.S.C. § 1319(g), EPA is authorized to issue orders assessing civil penalties for various violations of the CWA. EPA may issue such orders after the commencement of a Class I or Class II penalty proceeding. EPA provides public notice of the proposed assessment pursuant to 33 U.S.C. §1319(g)(4)(A) and 40 C.F.R. § 22.45.

Administrative civil penalty proceedings are conducted under EPA's "Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties, Issuance of Compliance or Corrective Action Orders and the Revocation, Termination or Suspension of Permits," 40 C.F.R. Part 22 (Consolidated Rules). The procedures through which the public may submit written comment on a proposed administrative penalty action or participate in an administrative proceeding, and the procedures by which a Respondent may request a hearing, are set forth in the Consolidated Rules. The deadline for submitting public comment on this administrative penalty proceeding is forty (40)

days after issuance of the Public Notice.

The Complaint addresses violations of the general pretreatment regulations found at Standard Printed Circuit, Inc.'s facility located at 44 South Main Street, Sherburne, New York 13460, where it operates, among other things, metal electroplating operations. Respondent failed to comply with the reporting requirements in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 403.12(e). EPA is seeking a proposed penalty of \$ 10,000. EPA has provided Respondent with a settlement offer of \$2,000 in an effort to promptly settle this matter.
