

## RFP for LFG Energy Project in Cape May County, NJ



As a service to our Partners and other interested parties, EPA's Landfill Methane Outreach Program (LMOP) is sharing information about a **request for proposals (RFP)** from the **Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority, NJ**. Please note that EPA is not affiliated in any way with the review and selection process. Information provided below is based on the RFP.

The Authority is seeking proposals to **develop (i.e., design, finance, permit, build, own, operate and maintain) a new landfill gas (LFG) beneficial use project** for the Authority's landfill located in Woodbine, NJ. The Authority currently has an LFG energy project that uses Jenbacher engines, but the equipment is nearing the end of its useful life. The Authority is **seeking an alternative project that beneficially uses the LFG in an environmentally sound manner, maximizes revenues and ensures continued compliance with permits**. The Authority will consider all demonstrated commercial technologies from financially capable and experienced LFG energy project developers.
