SmartWay Basics: What and Why?

- U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY
- EPA launched SmartWay in 2004 as a voluntary market-based program with the following goals:
 - Improve U.S. freight efficiency and reduce costs
 - Highlight industry best practices to reduce emissions
 - Provide a standardized benchmarking and emissions reporting system



- SmartWay is an integrated system: Covers all domestic modes including truck, rail, air, and barge, as well as 3rd Partly Logistics and Shipper companies
- SmartWay has been adopted by Canada and replicated by other countries around the globe
- Currently nearly 4,000 companies and organizations participate in SmartWay
- Saved \$52 billion in fuel costs; 379 million barrels of oil; and 162 million tons of emissions

Why do Carriers Need Clean Supply Chains?



- Simple Math: Fuel Used = Emissions Produced = \$\$\$ Lost
- Companies that are clean, are also efficient and efficient companies prosper and grow
- Competitive Edge: Carriers can offer their shipper customers a way to improve and highlight environmental responsibility
- They care about the communities they serve
- Visibility: Gives carriers another way to 'stand out'








Tool Development Timeline

- SmartWay 3.0 Tools (Online)
 - Online Truck Tool: 2020
 - Online Shipper Tool: 2021
 - Online Logistics Tool: 2022



SmartWay System Core Functionality







Changes due to going Online

- 🛸 Submit online, not via email
- Submit via PC, Mac, or large screen tablet device
- 🛸 Use any major web browser
- Saves data in your SmartWay partner portal
- Updates to Tools are applied instantaneously

- Solution Updates to Tools applied instantaneously
- More auto-populate options
- Real-time information on your carrier submittal status
- Seasier data management
- Better Navigation
- 🛸 Scalable to your screen size

The SmartWay Portal is a resource for SmartWay Partners and eligible companies that are interested in partnering up with SmartWay. The portal options that are listed below reflect what type of partner, prospect, or applicant you are (e.g., a Truck Carrier), as well as whether you are working with the US Environment Protection Agency or Natural Resources Canada. For example, partners can use this portal to obtain their SmartWay Registration document and SmartWay Logo files. If you have any questions, please contact your SmartWay Partner Account Manager or SmartWay recruiter.

You are designated as a Truck Carrier Partner. Your carrier modes and current status are shown below, including your current reporting status. It is important that you submit tools on time and that you do not accidentally re-submit an already approved tool. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact your Partner Account Manager (PAM).

Completing the Tool: General Dos and Don'ts




- The Tool generally saves as you proceed, however click Save and Continue to not lose your work on the current page
- Sometimes you can copy unknown code that adversely impacts tool operation
- < Always check your inputs
- For Company and Contact information, please make sure the information is correct and spelled correctly
- Take advantage of all the built in QA/QC functions within the Tool



12 Months of Data

- Required and Enforced
- 🛸 Existing Partners and Existing companies (full Calendar year)
- Newly formed companies (12 months contiguous data)
- If you do not have 12 months of data and are required to join SmartWay as a condition of hauling freight- you may request a one-time email from SmartWay indicating you do not have 12 months of data yet, but you intend to submit once you have it.

This Guide describes the SmartWay Online Truck Tool for all carriers (referred to as the OTT in this document), which can be used by all SmartWay truck carriers.



Online Truck Tool: Short Form

- SmartWay has a short form of the Truck Tool built for small carriers with non-complex fleets
- 20 Trucks or less
- Operates only One truck class (e.g. only operates class 8B vehicles)
- Only uses diesel or gasoline fuel (no alt fuels/EVs)
- Does not broker out loads
- Compatible with mobile phones, tablets, PCs



Performance Rankings

- SmartWay provides standardized emission results and relative rankings for all SmartWay carriers at the fleet level
- Carriers are categorized by type (such as truckload dry van, flatbed, or tanker) to insure an apples-toapples comparison.
- Section Emissions: CO₂, NOx, and PM
- Metrics: grams/mile and grams/ton-mile
- Within categories/emissions & metrics carriers are ranked on a 1-5 scale (1 being best, i.e. top 20%)



How Can Carriers Use SmartWay to Reduce their Emissions?



- Use your SmartWay Carrier tool reports to analyze your emissions
- Compare your fleets with each other to spot best practices or find deficiencies
- Distinguish yourself to attract and retain new shippers
- < Engage in peer-to-peer learning





Efficiency Strategies

- Improved Aerodynamic
- Idle Reduction
- Tire Inflation System
- Low Rolling Resistance Tires
- Low-Viscosity Lubricants
- Driver Training
- Reduced Highway Speeds
- Weight Reduction
