Re: Petition for Waiver of 2014 Renewable Fuel Standard

Dear Administrator McCarthy:

Delek Refining, Ltd. (“Delek” or the “Company”) respectfully submits this petition to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”) for a partial waiver of the 2014 applicable volumes of the Renewable Fuel Standard (“RFS”) pursuant to section 211(o)(7)(A) of the Clean Air Act.^[1]

Delek is an obligated party pursuant to regulations promulgated by EPA to implement the RFS (40 C.F.R Part 80, Subpart M). The Company is thus a person subject to the requirements of subsection 211(o) of the Clean Air Act. Delek also is a member of the American Fuel & Petrochemical Manufacturers (“AFPM”). Existing EPA administrative and judicial precedent makes clear that AFPM has standing to file an RFS waiver petition on behalf of member companies. Notwithstanding this understanding, Delek’s submittal incorporates by reference the RFS waiver petition filed by AFPM and the American Petroleum Institute on August 13, 2013.
