How to Enter & View Program Activity Levels (PALs) Data

PALs Reporting Requirement

State & Tribal Section 128(a) cooperative agreement recipients ("CARs") are required to report a summary of the *previous federal fiscal year's* work (October 1 through September 30), known as Program Activity Levels ("PALs") data. EPA encourages CARS to fulfill this requirement by submitting their PALs report directly in <u>EPA's ACRES database</u>. This quick reference guide provides instruction on how CARs can report PALs in ACRES.

Entering PALs data

From your ACRES Home page, start by clicking PALs Form to Complete on the Program Activity Levels (PALs) card. You can also access the report by clicking the Reports drop down menu and selecting Add Annual PALs Data.
