Updating & Submitting the State Brownfields and Voluntary Response Programs Report


State Section 128(a) cooperative agreement recipients ("CARs") are required to update their State Brownfields and Voluntary Response Program information in the ACRES database at least once a year. This quick reference guide provides instructions on how State CARs can access, update, and submit this information.

Entering and submitting State information

 From the top of your ACRES Home page, start by clicking State Reports to Review on the State & Tribal Reports card. You can also access the report by clicking the Reports drop down menu and selecting Review State Reports.



 On your State report list, you can view previously approved State reports by clicking the Approved Reports link. To update a report, find the Organization's report you would like to update and click Edit Draft. This link will open the State report.


