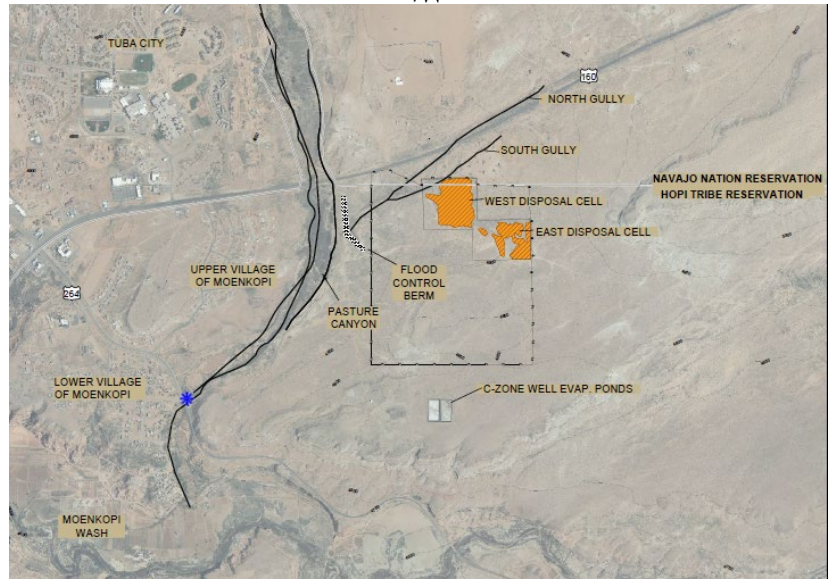

# Community Meetings about Tuba City Dump

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is holding meetings to inform the public regarding an Administrative Order on Consent (an agreement) that has been signed by Region 9 EPA with BIA for the cleanup and closure of Tuba City Dump. These meetings will be held jointly with Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), Hopi Department of Natural Resources, and Navajo Nation EPA. The aim of the public meetings is to inform the public of the Administrative Order on Consent and listen to public feedback.

Public comments are encouraged and instructions on how to submit one can be found on the public notice website. The due date for public comments is **June 28, 2024**.
