As described in the application, the facility is located at 346 Forest Road 314, city of Jemez Springs, Sandoval County, NM. Under the SIC code 0921, the facility hatches and raises Rio Grande cutthroat trout for stocking in lakes and streams with estimated production maximum of 10,200 lbs annually. Water sources are Calaveras, Cebolla, Coldwater and Seven Springs; some of the spring's waters are oxygenated before being utilized.

This is a renewal of a permit previously issued on February 22, 2019, with an effective date of April 1, 201, 2019, and an expiration date of March 21, 2024. The following are changes from the previous permit:

- 1. The long-term 30-day average flow of 0.77 MGD reported in the application at Outfall 001has been used per NMIP to calculate the permit limitations.
- 2. Added monitoring for newly approved NMWQS to the draft permit. They must be collected and analyzed within the first year of the permit effective date. Submit the results to both EPA and NMED.
