Dear Mr. Meyers:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency received the December 26, 2023, petition from The Chemours Company for reconsideration of the final rule, "Phasedown of Hydrofluorocarbons: Restrictions on the Use of Certain Hydrofluorocarbons Under the American Innovation and Manufacturing Act of 2020" (88 FR 73098, October 24, 2023).

The petition identified as grounds for reconsideration the concept of "specified components" that were not part of the proposed rule and alleged this would result in a delay of the rule's implementation and differential treatment between domestic and non-U.S. manufacturing. Pursuant to Clean Air Act section 307(d)(7)(B), the EPA grants reconsideration of the final rule on the issue raised in your petition. The EPA intends to develop a proposed action on this matter.
