## Re: Supplemental Information on Petition for Administrative Reconsideration

Dear Ms. Newberg:

The undersigned organizations representing the U.S. heating, ventilation, air conditioning, and refrigeration industry (HVACR) are writing to provide further information regarding our Petition for Administrative Reconsideration submitted on December 21, 2023, of "Phasedown of Hydrofluorocarbons: Restrictions on the Use of Certain Hydrofluorocarbons Under the American Innovation and Manufacturing Act of 2020," 88 Fed. Reg. 73098 (Oct. 24, 2023).

Specifically, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has requested clarification on the scope of the petitioned prohibition on the manufacture and import of R-410A condensing units. The petition identified residential and light commercial air conditioning and heat pump condensing unit components designed for use in configurations with a single condenser and a single evaporator with R-410A.

In response to EPA's request to refine the scope further, the petitioners propose refining the prohibition by limiting it to single and three phase residential and light commercial air conditioners and heat pumps less than 65,000 BTUs.
