Dear Ms. Walter-Terrinoni:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency received Trane Technologies' December 23, 2023, petition for reconsideration of the final rule, "Phasedown of Hydrofluorocarbons: Restrictions on the Use of Certain Hydrofluorocarbons Under the American Innovation and Manufacturing Act of 2020" (88 FR 73098, October 24, 2023).

The petition identified as grounds for reconsideration that the rule may apply to intermodal refrigerated transport of deep-frozen cargo that require temperatures above -50°C and below -35°C, including life sciences products such as blood plasma and pharmaceuticals. The EPA will reconsider this issue and will evaluate whether there is a need to revise the restrictions for the intermodal refrigerated transport subsector. The EPA intends to initiate reconsideration of this issue and intends to develop a proposed action on this matter.
