Users of electrical transmission and distribution equipment insulated with sulfur hexafluoride (SF₆) and/or perfluorocarbons (PFCs) must measure or estimate these parameters (annually):

When measuring SF₆ emissions using the mass-balance monitoring method:

Note: When measuring PFCs, "PFCs" should be substituted for "SF₆" in the parameters below.

- □ SF₆ stored in containers, but not in energized equipment, at the beginning of the year (pounds (lbs)).
- □ SF₆ stored in containers, but not in energized equipment, at the end of the year (lbs).
- □ SF₆ purchased in bulk from chemical producers or distributors (lbs).
- □ SF₆ purchased from equipment manufacturers or distributors with or inside equipment, including hermetically sealed-pressure equipment (lbs).
- \square SF₆ returned to facility after off-site recycling (lbs).
- □ SF₆ in bulk and contained in equipment that is sold to other entities (lbs).
- \Box SF₆ returned to suppliers (lbs).
- \Box SF₆ sent off-site for recycling (lbs).
- \square SF₆ sent off-site for destruction (lbs).
- □ Nameplate capacity and the number of pieces of new equipment, hermetically sealed-pressure switchgear (lbs).
- □ Nameplate capacity and the number of pieces of new equipment, other than hermetically sealed-pressure switchgear (lbs).
- □ Nameplate capacity and the number of pieces of retired hermetically sealed-pressure equipment (lbs).
- □ Nameplate capacity and the number of pieces of retired equipment other than hermetically sealedpressure equipment (lbs).

Supplemental information required for data reporting requirements:

- □ Total nameplate capacity (lbs) of equipment containing SF₆ or PFCs existing at the beginning of the year (excluding hermetically sealed-pressure equipment).
- □ Transmission miles (length of lines carrying voltages above 35 kilovolts (kV)).
- Distribution miles (length of lines carrying voltages at or below 35 kV).
- □ States and territories in which the facility lies.
