The discharge from this facility is located at 76 Taos Road, San Felipe Pueblo, in Sandoval County, New Mexico. Under the SIC code 4952, the applicant operates a WWTP. The facility has a design flow capacity of 0.6 MGD providing sanitary services for population of 1,250 approximately, a travel center and a casino. Phase I with capacity of 0.3 MGD has been completed and in operation; 0.6 MGD in phase II has not been completed yet. Effluent from the facility is discharged into San Felipe Eastside Ditch, an intermittent tributary of the Rio Grande River in Segment 20.6.4.110 of the Rio Grande Basin.

Changes from the permit previously issued on August 20, 2019, with an effective date of October 1, 2019, and an expiration date of September 30, 2024, are as follow:

- 1. Per-and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) Monitoring Requirements has been added to the draft permit.
- 2. Added influent data reporting requirements for BOD and TSS on DMRs.
