EPA will assign a tracking code to alert reviewers to the relationship between the applications, but the fee category will depend upon the action requested in the secondary application.

The number of uses is tracked in the Agency's tracking system using a decimal to reflect the number of uses requested, i.e. one new use – R170; three new uses – R170x3, etc.

1. A single conventional non-food outdoor new use is requested. The application package requests a label amendment to a registered technical product and to four registered end-use products.

2. A single conventional new food use is requested. The package consists of a tolerance petition, a label amendment to a registered technical product and one new end-use product registration application (containing the new use) with product chemistry and acute toxicity data.

3. A new non-food indoor antimicrobial use is requested. The package consists of label amendments to an existing technical and one existing end-use product label and one new end-use product registration application (with product chemistry and acute toxicity data). The proposed new end-use product best matches the description of the A460 PRIA category, which has an associated fee of \$7,689.

4. Three conventional new food uses are requested. The package consists of a tolerance petition, label amendments to an existing registered technical product and two existing end-use products, and one new end-use product registration application (containing the new uses) with product chemistry and acute toxicity data. The proposed new end-use product represents a new physical form of the active ingredient and best matches the description of the R320 PRIA category, which has an associated fee of \$19,906.
