Subject: Modification to 2023 Administrative Consent Order between the US EPA, US Navy, and Defense Logistics Agency on the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility and Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam

Dear Deputy Assistant Secretary Ohannessian and Vice Director Bunn:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) has signed Amendment No. 1 to the 2023 Administrative Consent Order for Defueling, Closure, and Drinking Water Protection for the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility and Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam Water System ("the ACO"). The ACO and Amendment are agreements between the US EPA, U.S. Department of the Navy, and Defense Logistics Agency, collectively referred to as the "parties." The amendment focuses specifically on the Community Outreach and Community Involvement portions of the ACO. Along with the Amendment, the parties have agreed to an Initial Community Engagement Plan to implement the revised ACO as well as Community Representation Initiative Ground Rules.
