# A. WQX Status Report

### 2. WQP Status Report (10 mins) (Candice and Lee)

We discussed the recent performance issues that hit the Portal this past week. The underlying cause was really driven by traffic, a number of congruent users, hung queries, and a background ETL of the WQX upload to the database that caused the CPU to be maxed out close to 100%. This forced us to shutdown, close hung queries, and implement some solutions to slow/queue traffic and kill any hung queries on the database side.

We want to hear if you experience any performance issues moving forward now that user ratelimiting and hung query termination is in effect. On average, we have between 10-20 users hitting the services at any micro-second. When we were being brought down, users were hovering around 60. Now, if traffic is high, users may receive a 429 error because we are limiting users to 20 at a time.

Q - Is WQP user rate limiting here to stay? A - Yes. We may iterate based on feedback and any resource adjustments.

Q - We were getting query results back but they were incomplete. The same query would return different subsets of results. A - Need to investigate if it was PROD or BETA.

Q - Any possibility of implementing an optional known user key? A - That is not something we have explored at this time.

Q - Any guidance on how hung queries are defined (i.e. big vs slow ones)? A - It's best to keep queries as simple as possible. If anticipating a large return, could break up the query by year.
