A quick update on LMOP activities:

- In April 2024, we published a new fact sheet "[Considering Environmental Justice \(EJ\) in LFG Energy Project Development](#)" and a complementary webpage "[Using the LMOP National Map](#)". These new resources are intended to provide basic information about EJ, suggested actions for community engagement, and instructions on using LMOP's map, all within the context of understanding and addressing EJ concerns related to LFG energy project development.
- LMOP presented on the above new resources at the S.O.A.R. event in April 2024 and demonstrated how to use the LMOP map; our [presentation slides are available online](#).
- In December 2023, LMOP hosted a webinar about electricity generation options for landfills in a remote location or with a low LFG flow rate, while our webinar in September 2023 presented information about detecting landfill methane emissions with drones.
