RE: Withdrawal of Elements of California's Request for Authorization, Pursuant to Clean Air Act Section 209(e)(2), of the Zero-Emission Truck TRU Requirements of the Airborne Toxic Control Measure for In-Use Diesel-Fueled Transport Refrigeration Units (TRU) and TRU Generator Sets, and Facilities Where TRUs Operate (TRU ATCM), Docket ID EPA-HQ-OAR-2024-0030.

Dear Acting Administrator Nishida:

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) appreciates U.S. EPA's recent partial authorization of its Transport Refrigeration Unit Regulation (TRU Regulation).¹

In its action, U.S. EPA did not act on the Zero-Emission (ZE) TRU "requirements for the turnover of at least 15 percent of [the] diesel-fueled truck TRU fleet to ZETRU by December 31, 2023, (and each year thereafter" within the 2022 TRU Amendments.² CARB withdraws its request for authorization of these ZETRU requirements.
