Dear Mr. Bond:

I would like to inform you of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's response to the Edison Electric Institute petition for reconsideration of the final action, "New Source Performance Standards for Greenhouse Gas Emissions From New, Modified, and Reconstructed Fossil Fuel-Fired Electric Generating Units; Emission Guidelines for Greenhouse-Gas Emissions From Existing Fossil Fuel-Fired Electric Generating Units; and Repeal of the Affordable Clean Energy Rule," published in the *Federal Register* May 9, 2024.

After careful consideration of the issues raised, the EPA is partially denying the petition; that is, the EPA is denying reconsideration on some issues in your petition and taking no action on others. The reasons for this conclusion are fully set forth in an enclosed document, "The EPA's Basis for Denying, in Part or Whole, Petitions for Reconsideration of the New Source Performance Standards for Greenhouse Gas Emissions From New, Modified, and Reconstructed Fossil Fuel-Fired Electric Generating Units; Emission Guidelines for Greenhouse-Gas Emissions From Existing Fossil Fuel-Fired Electric Generating Units; and Repeal of the Affordable Clean Energy Rule."
